**NEW OPTION FOR HOT LUNCH:** Zucca's Restaurant is coming to Marshview Public School's Hot Lunch Program. Zucca's will be offering students a variety of options including pastas, chicken fingers, rice balls, meat ball sandwiches and more! Zucca's will be available on School Cash Online, and served at first Nutrition Break. The portion sizes are considerable, so we are having food delivered for first Nutrition Break so students can finish any leftovers during the second Nutrition Break.

**SORA:** SORA is a digital collection of ebooks and audiobooks that is available for all staff and students of SCDSB. There are a number of curated collections for students to select titles from; for example, beginner chapter books, picture books, Indigenous Voices, etc.

1. Go to <http://simcoecountyca.libraryreserve.com>. It will ask your student to log into their SCDSB Google account.
2. Once logged in, click on **Explore** and look for an available title. You can also search for a specific title.
3. When you find a book you would like to read online, click **Borrow**. The book will then open for you to read online.
4. Any books you borrow will be listed under **Shelf** at the bottom of the screen.
5. When done with a book, click on Shelf. Beside the book you will see an Options tab. Open that and then click on return.
6. If someone has a book checked out, you can place a **Hold** on it and Sora will send you a notification once it is available.
7. You can also translate the language of books. Once the book is open, click on the Google Translate extension. Select the language you would like to read the book in. Google Translate works for many books, however, will not work for graphic novels.

**INCLEMENT WEATHER UPDATES:** In the event that buses are cancelled, hot lunches will also be cancelled. Families who choose to bring their children to school are responsible for transportation to and from school. Dismissal is at 3:50 p.m., please be prepared to pick up your children promptly.

**INCLEMENT WEATHER ABSENCES/SAFE ARRIVAL:** If your child is absent on an inclement weather day and you receive a Safe Arrival call, please listen to the entire message. You are only required to call the school if you believe your child should be at school. The message on Inclement Weather Days is as follows:

**Please listen to the entire message, then press 1 to acknowledge or press \* to repeat. If you do not press 1 to acknowledge, you may receive additional calls. Although the school remains open, school busses have been cancelled due to inclement weather. You are receiving this call because one or more students in this household is absent from Marshview Public School, on < absence date>. Do not call the school unless you believe your child should be at school. To access Safe Arrival at Marshview Public School, call 1-888-885-8065. Press 1 to acknowledge you have received this message. Press \* to repeat this message.**

**SCHOOL ACCESS INFORMATION:** Please send students to school with lunch and all items they need for the day. There are limited staff available to answer the door for forgotten items. School doors are locked as per the SCDSB Safe School Policy. Please ensure that your students have plenty of lunch, snacks, water, extra clothing in their backpacks for washroom accidents and have appropriate clothing for the weather (ie: hats, mittens and snowpants). If you know you will be signing your child out early, we ask that you email the office directly up to 24 hours ahead of the dismissal time. Please send emails to [marshview@scdsb.on.ca](mailto:marshview@scdsb.on.ca) Please do not email the teacher directly as the office will not receive these messages if the teacher is away. Once you arrive at the school, we will call your child(ren) down to the office.

#### **HOW EMAILING AHEAD HELPS WITH EARLY DISMISSALS:**

- Students spend time in many different areas of our school such as the gym, library, visits to other classrooms and the music room. By notifying the office of an early pickup the teacher can ensure that

your student will have all their belongings with them and the office can locate the student easily once you arrive.

- Teachers can make sure that the student has enough time to clean up any projects that they are working on before you arrive and where possible teachers can plan classroom activities with consideration to the student leaving early (ie; tests and presentations)
- The office can notify supply teachers in the event that the classroom teacher is absent.
- The office can notify you if your planned arrival time is during recess. Students are with duty teachers during the breaks, and it can be difficult to locate them.

**BUS DELAYS AND INFORMATION:** The Transportation Consortium provides bussing service for eligible students across Simcoe County. They are responsible for communicating delays to families through their website at <https://scstc.ca/Alerts> - Live updates are posted there, so we suggest that families bookmark this website and check it if busses are not on time.

Please continue to leave your child's name, with the spelling of their last name, their teacher's name, the reason for the absence, and their date of return.

**KISS N' RIDE:** Thank you for your support and patience as we continue to adjust our drop off and dismissal procedures at our new school. Following and respecting staff direction is appreciated! For students who are eligible for bussing, we encourage families to access this service. For walking students, we encourage them to take advantage of the Spring weather to walk to school. Further communication about drop off and dismissal procedures has been sent out previously, which has included an updated map. Please review these procedures carefully! Thank you for your support in keeping our students safe! PLEASE DO NOT DROP YOUR CHILD OFF ON SIMCOE ROAD – if you are dropping your child off, please use our Kiss N' Ride or drop them off at a location near to the school so they can walk the remainder of the way – Dropping them off on Simcoe Road is dangerous – By-Law officers have informed us that they are monitoring this. **We would also ask families to be mindful of their speed when driving into our school parking lot!** Please refer to the Kiss N' Ride Procedures and map that has been sent out separately and posted on our school website.
