<u>NUTRITION BREAK CHANGES:</u> As previously communicated, Nutrition Breaks have slightly changed as we moved into the new building. Kindergarten – Grade 1 students (including Ms. Almond's Grade 1/2 class) now have nutrition breaks at 11:10 a.m. – 11:30 a.m. & 1:30 p.m. – 1:50 p.m. Grades 2 – 8 students now have nutrition breaks at 11:30 a.m. & 1:50 p.m. – 2:10 p.m.
